## IMPORTANT NOTICE ABOUT COVID-19

As we are sure you are aware, there is currently a novel coronavirus outbreak happening worldwide, known as COVID-19. We are hopeful that this outbreak can be contained and that the mass panic being caused will slow down; but until that happens we must take proper sanitary precautions in helping prevent the spread of the coronavirus.



## Stay home if...

- If you feel sick
- Have sick family members in your household
- Experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, such as cough, fever, shortness of breath, etc.



## Practice good hygiene

- Clean hands regularly
- Avoid touching your face
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then dispose of said tissue in the garbage



## **During Funeral Services and Visitations**

- Avoid physical contact with others, instead of shaking hands or giving hugs, use non-contact greetings to express your sympathy
- During prayer services or during services at the church we ask that you forgo shaking hands during the sign of peace and instead greet your neighbor with a bow and the words "peace be with you"
- In church you may be asked to be seated in every other row of the church
- We recommend if you are sick or feel sick to use alternative ways to express your sympathy such as sending flowers or making a memorial donation
- If you feel as though you must pay your respects and may be experiencing symptoms, we ask that you wear a mask and pay your respect to the deceased and keep interaction with others to a minimum
